Hints:

The whole Old Testament is filled with hints, prophecies telling the life of Jesus. It was so much that when the disciples went out to tell the Good News, they did not have to begin by writing the Gospels. They already had all the details written out for them. All they had to do was open the books of the Old Testament and show others how it was already told by God hundreds of years before. (Just to put that into perspective – our nation is 241 years old dating from 1776; but the last Old Testament book dates to about 400 B.C. That is a long time to wait between the writing and the fulfilling.)

Two Amazing Things:

Two things are absolutely remarkable about this. **First** is that God actually did tell so many details about the life of Jesus; all of them written out and inviting every person in that time to believe in the promise that was coming. And a multitude did. Not only Jews. Many from other nations heard and believed. Some of them are: Jethro of Midian, Melchizedek of Salem, Ruth of Moab, Rahab of Jericho, Uriah the Hittite, many of the people of Nineveh as well as the sailors on the boat with Jonah, and the list goes on. God has always been calling from far and wide. In the prophecies God shows His hand. Writing out this kind of detail centuries before and fulfilling all of it is absolutely unique. It has never been repeated – has never been tried by anyone else. It could only be done by someone who already sees and knows the future; only the true God.

The second amazing thing is this. After telling in detail (my Bible has 803 pages in the Old Testament; and what we say in our Bible Studies and Youth Group meetings is "Jesus on every page.") – after telling in detail what He was going to do ((drum roll)) IT WAS STILL A SURPRISE WHEN GOD DID IT. How do you do that??

When I want to do a surprise party I have to be all kinds of tricky. And even then, half the time the wife says "I knew what you were up to." But God tells exactly what He is up to. For 803 pages He tells His people what He is up to. And then when He does it He absolutely amazes them. (We're talking the jaw dropping, not knowing what to say, try to figure out what's next and get it completely wrong, kind of amazement. The amazement that is so complete that people look confused, kind of amazement.)

((Go ahead, I dare you, ask all the Christians you know if Jesus is still amazing. You know what you'll hear?))

Here's the reason. No matter how much you learn about Jesus, no matter what the anticipation; Jesus will always far surpass anything you could ever hope for.

Christmas then:

Year after year as we draw close to Christmas there is a sense of the immense. The full measure of what God has done is way beyond our understanding.

Jesus' birth changes everything in heaven and on earth.

When God became man He changed what it means to be man.

When Jesus took flesh on Himself, He brought our flesh into communion with God.

When He was born in a stable and laid in a manger, He revealed an unexpected part of the character of God. The humble God (think about that!) who comes to serve was going to fully reveal that part of who He is on

the cross.

Christmas is the time when we learn every year that there are amazing things unfolding and things beyond our imagination happening. Jesus' birth is the beginning of all that is to come; and He will continue unfolding His kingdom until we are standing before His throne amazed again, and singing and celebrating.

May this Christmas be for you a time of reflection, a time of peace, and a time of amazement as you ponder the love of God revealed in the stable and the manger of Jesus.

Remember the Special Activities and Worship Services of this season.




